



You can not dive if you have one of the following symptoms:

Fever

Cough

Difficulty in breathing

Anyone entering the Dive Center, including all staff and guests will undergo a mandated temperature screening.



If you have been in a high risk COVID-19 area or you have been in contact with infected people, please contact your doctor before reaching the diving center.

AT THE DIVING CENTER



We have setup a table outside so it is not necessary to enter the office.

Use the indoor space as little as possible and maintain your social distancing of 2m. A maximum of 5 people can be inside, at any one time.

A signed liability form, copy of ID and diving certification to be sent by WhatsApp or email at the time of booking.

Briefing will be conducted in the outside area in small groups.

Face Masks are mandatory at all times
- except in the water!

AT THE DIVING CENTER

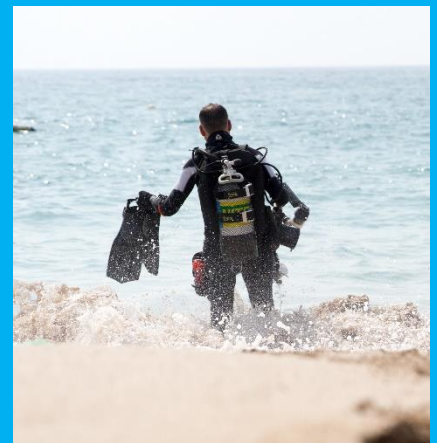


Please make use of the outside benches as well as the equipment room to setup your equipment. No overcrowding of a single specific area.

Our staff will be hovering around if you need any help.

During this time, you will need to be as independent as possible in assembling your gear and getting ready for the dive.

Also after the dive – disassembly and sanitization!



ABOUT THE EQUIPMENT



Rental equipment is sanitized after each use and stored.

If you have your own equipment, please feel free to make use of our disinfectant but, please, make sure you rinse in fresh water afterwards.

Disinfectant is available also on the boat for your mask and mouthpiece.

Do not use saliva to defog your mask before entering the water to lessen the risk of cross-contamination. Use a defogging solution instead.



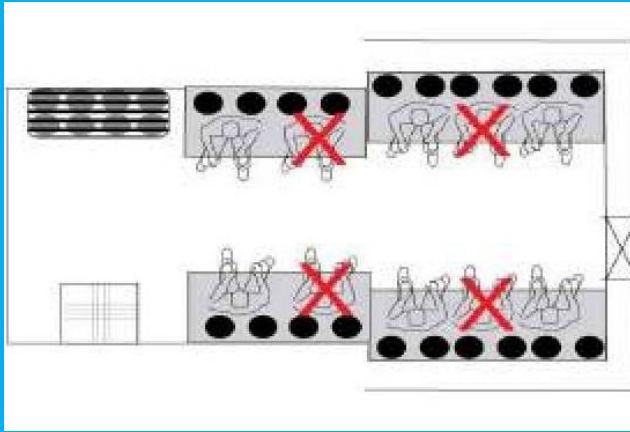

Do not leave regulators or sensitive parts lying on non-sterilized surface.



ON THE BOAT



In order to ensure the social distancing, there will be a maximum of 5 divers on the boat. Please respect the distancing rule. You will need to keep mask and fins with you and not leaving **ANYTHING** under the captain's responsibility.

At this time being, we will not be able to provide any snacks or food, on the boat.



For the water, you will need to use your own refillable bottle. However, if you do not have, we can provide you one. You can buy it or just use one of ours for the day. The refillable bottle will be sterilized after use.

ON THE BOAT

Face masks are mandatory.

Getting on and off the boat will be done whilst respecting social distancing.

Remove your face mask and put your diving mask on immediately. Put your regulator in your mouth as well. Once in the water, maintain your distance.

Enjoy your dive – AS NORMAL!

After the dive, do not remove your mask or regulator until you are back on the boat, seated and ready to put your face mask back on.

Do not touch your face until you have sanitized your hands.

All of these procedures will be a little bit different and we all need to think very carefully – not just about ourselves, but everybody else as well.



GENERAL ETIQUETTE



Masks are mandatory at all times. Both in the center and on the boat.



Sanitizer and disinfectant are available all around the diving center and on the boat for you to use.

All the common areas of the center and on the boat, are constantly disinfected throughout the day.

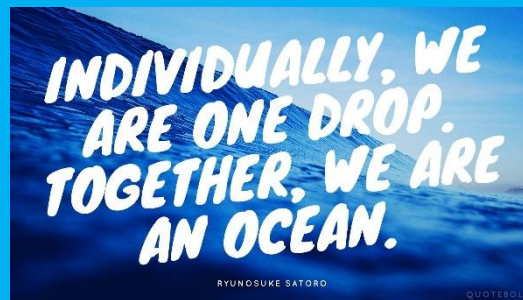


2 MINUTES REFLECTION
